Boulder Park, Inc. has proven to be an innovative leader in biosolids management in the Pacific Northwest. Boulder Park has demonstrated this by their commitment to:

- Emphasizing the importance of stakeholder engagement as a necessary element to a successful biosolids project
- Recognizing the benefits of biosolids as a soil conditioner and nutrient source by providing monetary value to participating biosolids agencies
- Supporting long-term biosolids research to enhance our knowledge of the effects of land application of biosolids in agriculture
- Serving as proud local sponsors for what could be the largest full-scale, farmer cooperative biosolids project in the United States

Biosolids Program Summary:

- * Since 1992, Boulder Park, Inc. (BPI) has beneficially reused more than 1,000,000 tons of biosolids
- * BPI has provided biosolids application and haul services to over 30 large and small wastewater agencies throughout the state of Washington
- * Over 16 years of biosolids research has been conducted on site by Washington State University
- * Growing demand for biosolids has increased the number of participating farmers from 3 to more than 120, from 30,000 wet tons/year to 85,000 wet tons/year
